Each customer has a dedicated team, which allows for customized service from the sampling stage to the final loading of the containers and completing the logistic side to ensure safe and timely arrival of containers.

Management Team:

This consists of a group of people who have 33 years of past experience in manufacturing and have produced for some of the best companies in the world including Carhartt, Wrangler, Levis, H.D Lee, DKNY, Speedo, Calvin Klien, Sears, Macy's, and various European Department stores and National Chain stores.

The Q.C and Q.A

The team has a group of 12 qualified people who have been trained to understand fabrics, sewn products before and after wash to ensure the specs and shrinkage of the fabrics and overall appearance meets the required Standards.

The I.T department

Transforms all documents to e files, which are forwarded to our customers on a weekly basis giving them the true position and status of the orders placed and to avoid any surprises at a later stage.

Logistic:

We have allocated in house staff who work with reliable shipping companies and forwarders who in turn represent international carriers who understand deadlines and arrival of goods with offices around the world to follow thru the containers safety and timely arrival of goods as committed.

Factory evaluation

This is done on strict formats prior to placing an order or handing over any information to the Vendors, this includes the following:

1. Factory visit.
2. Factory evaluation of People, Machines, Formats, Background checks, Market reputation, and financial strength of the company.
3. Labor law implementation, ensuring no Child Labor and Compliance Requirements are followed.

Weekly reporting:

The weekly reporting system to our customers from the initial stage to the shipment of the goods helps us in correcting problems as they come up.

List of Weekly Reports include for approved Vendors:

1. Sample and Sales Sample request form
2. Fabric Inspection Report and Lab Tests reports.
3. Trims Test Report and arrival report
4. Cutting, Sewing, washing, finishing and in line Quality controls Reports

Finance:

We assist our customers and vendors with all documentations, customs forms and Formalities where needed, including the follow up on the L/C's and payments.

Turn around time:

In most cases where we use domestic fabrics we complete an order within 75 to 90 days from receiving the full details from the customer and their financial commitment

In case of imported fabrics we need additional 60 days.

Treatments for Work Wear and Active Wear

We have and are able to produce garments with the following treatments and finishes:

1. Teflon treatment by Dupont on fabric prior to production and on finished garments for woven and knits.
2. Fire protection.
3. Coolmax for knit wear items
4. Cordura by In vista treated fabrics.
5. Coolmax.by In vista treated fabrics.
6. Wrinkle free process on finished Garments.

Fabrics Used:

100% cottons in twills, Canvas, Denims and Cords,

CVC and CVS including denims and Twills in 4 to 15 oz weights

100% polyester fabrics. From 2 to 14 oz weights.

All fabrics are preshrunk and are lab tested with reports provided where requested.

Knits

We can provide in 100% cotton or CVC or CVS various weights and type of knits as requested by the customer, some of the best brands are being produced

Here and all factories are able to handle the embroidery on the product.

Styles and product Type:

We work with Vendors who specialize in there area of work and allocate production in the lines which have at least 2 to 3 years of experience making a certain type of Garment.

In Knit Wear we are able to cover both tops and bottoms, along with pull on or zip front Jackets.

All above products are made to specifications of the customer and in Mens and Ladies.

Accessories:

These are made with the customers Brand and as required, we use spun polyester or Poly core threads of the correct counts to make sure they stand the required Number of washes.
