



Post Show Report – EXPOKOS 2022

After a break of two years, and all the challenges and obstacles of the pandemic, we managed to organize the 21st Edition of the EXPOKOS International Fair. This year, under the patronage of the Prime Minister of the Republic of Kosovo, it was once again proven that EXPOKOS is the most important event in the Western Balkans for businesses in the construction, energy, machinery, safety, and security sectors.

Alongside businesses in these sectors who attended as exhibitors, we were also very pleased to have the participation of the University of Prishtina's Architecture Faculty. The faculty presented its students' projects, the curriculum that it offers and the services that it provides as an institution.

The fair was opened by the Deputy Prime Minister of the Republic of Kosovo, Mr. Besnik Bislimi, who emphasized how the government is working every day to create an environment to attract foreign investments.

The government also offered direct support for local businesses who have ambitions to expand in the Balkans, through their financial support for a producer pavilion. By participating in EXPOKOS, local companies had the opportunity to meet foreign companies and visitors with whom some agreements have already been signed on cooperation and expansion of businesses into German-speaking countries.

In his speech, Mr. Bislimi also confirmed that future editions of EXPOKOS will again be organized in cooperation with the Government of the Republic of Kosovo.

After the Deputy Prime Minister, the Minister for the Economy – Ms. Artane Rizvanolli – gave a speech where she unfolded the government strategy and plans regarding the energy sector for 2022-2030. She stressed the focus on attracting foreign investments to develop renewable energy.



The impact of attracting new investors will be positive in many ways and will lead to the participation of more exhibitors from the renewable energy sector in future editions of EXPOKOS which will also help to increase public awareness about this important sector.

The Minister for Industry, Entrepreneurship and Trade, Ms. Rozeta Hajdari, didn't miss the chance to promote the advantages of doing business in Kosovo, giving a speech where she set out Kosovo's advantages such as competitive wages, high production quality, competitive prices and government support for companies who decide to relocate at least a part of their production sector to Kosovo. The Minister also made one-to-one visits to speak with foreign exhibitors at the fair.
